



## Statement

The Sebbin Group placed in judicial liquidation proceedings

Dear Madam, Sir,

The Sebbin group has been placed in judicial liquidation proceedings without continuation of activity by decision dated March 3 by the Commercial Court of Pontoise.

The Sebbin company has been confronted with industrial waste for many years, without any health consequences. The scrap rate linked to the difficulties encountered in the implementation of manufacturing processes does not pose any risk to patients, since the non-compliant products have never been marketed. However, these industrial difficulties have weighed heavily on the financial situation of Sebbin.

In an attempt to get out of these financial difficulties, Sebbin benefited from a recovery plan by the Pontoise Commercial Court a year ago when it was in a situation of insolvency. However, the industrial and financial difficulties proved to be greater and more numerous than initially anticipated and irreversibly altered the profitability of the Sebbin group, which is unable to break even in the years to come.

The decision follows months of searching for alternative solutions and considerable efforts to save the company.

Everything is done in this context, to support each employee of the Sebbin group, and to respond to practitioners.

Since March 4, no product can be shipped or invoiced by the Sebbin Group in France. However, products already placed on the market in the various countries as well as those held in stock depot in France, can be used, without commercial guarantee.

Maître Aymeric Mandin, in his capacity as judicial liquidator, now administers and manages the company, and can in particular deal with:

- Any information related to the judicial liquidation procedure;
- Creditors' requests;
- Calls for tenders with French institutions;
- Contracts in force.
